### Rules and Conditions:

- 1) The salute award is designed to recognize country music songwriters and their songs.  
The Awards are only open to material wholly written and recorded in Australia or New Zealand by Australian and/ or New Zealand residents and commercially released for distribution in Australia and/or New Zealand for the first time between 16th October 2009 and 15th October 2010. The material ,both lyrics and music must be original. Commercially released is determined to mean that 500 or more copies of any one title have been prepared for sale or commercial use. The judging is carried out on the nominated track, a trophy only will be awarded to the winner.
- 2) No more than one track per composer or writing team per category. The same song cannot be entered in more than one category.
- 3) Entries close 5 Pm 15 October 2010 , late entries not accepted.
- 4) All categories will be judged by a panel of five, appointed by the TSA.
- 5) Nominations must be accompanied by (5) five commercially released CD's, containing each nominated track ( copies or dubs are not acceptable). If all tracks are on the same CD then a total of (5) of the one CD will be sufficient. CD's will not be returned to the entrants, there is NO ENTRY FEE.
- 6) Eligibility of the nomination to each category will be subject to the discretion of the judging panel.
- 7) Nominations will be restricted to one song per writer /composer per category. Where co-writers are involved each different combination counts as a different entry.
- 8) TSA Song of the Year is selected from winners of the six nominated categories.
- 9) Winners of all awards will be announced during the TSA Songwriters Concert see website for details.
- 10) All matters relating to the conduct of the Songwriters' Salute are under the control of the TSA or its nominees. The TSA will use its best endeavours to ensure that all conditions relating to the nominations and judging are fulfilled. The TSA cannot be held responsible for any digression or non-compliance in any matter. All matters relating to judging will be strictly confidential. Decisions will be final and no correspondence will be entered into.
